
Action taken report on feedback of stakeholders

It was found that, according to all the stakeholders, the curriculum was adequate, however few teachers suggested about inclusion of recent advances in the field of Medicine in the curriculum. Few faculty teachers suggested need for horizontal integration of few subjects with other specialties. There was also suggestion about including Medico-legal aspects of medicine & emphasis on patient counseling. The faculty teachers also suggested that, more scope should be given for research.

Based on above suggestions, the curriculum committee of the department instructed all the faculty teachers to include recent advances during their lectures & tutorials and also take help from other specialties for horizontal integration of a particular topic. The faculty teachers were also instructed to include medico-legal aspects & patient counseling during bed side teaching to UG and PG students. The PG students were instructed to carry out research under the guidance of faculty, other than their thesis.

Student feedback analysis was discussed and following points were decided -


- a. forward suggestion to Library incharge to include sufficient copies of all relevant textbooks and reference books in library for easy access to students.





Curriculum committee of the Department of Psychiatry was held on 29th June 2019, which was attended by curriculum committee members & faculty teachers.


Feedback received from the faculty teachers, PG students & Alumina was discussed and analyzed.
