Brief about the Program (Activity/Event details)	 The activity of 'Swacchta Abhiyan' was conducted at Mohadi and Janori villages by NSS students of Dr. Vasantrao Pawar Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Nashik. A team of 40 NSS students from Dr. VPMCH & RC Nashik used to gather at the temple of the Janori village and call all villagers over there for the awareness about the Swacchta in houses and surrounding area. They also told them how the dry and wet waste to be segregated for the purpose of appropriate waste disposal. People were also sensitized that wet waste especially kitchen waste can be converted into manure and which can be used for kitchen garden. Posters were made for various

- issues of waste management. Social places like temples, bazars and chowks were used as the places for awareness.
- Another team of 10 NSS students performed street plays / Nukkad nataks regarding Swacchata awareness at various places in these villages of Nashik District.
- Students went at almost each and every door in the Mohadi & Janori village. They interacted with the family members regarding their ideas about waste disposal, diseases spread by unhygienic environment and told them the various ways to prevent and control the same. Verbal one to one interaction at family level was done. Students used to go in a team of 2-3 students for discussion on the swacchata activity.
- Two faculties from Dept of Community Medicine guided these NSS volunteers for the above mentioned activities.
- Programme concluded by giving vote of thanks to those who were involved in the programme.
